

**TOWN OF SAMPSON
SPECIAL MEETING
10 April 2017**

A Special Meeting of the Sampson Town Board was called to order on Monday, 10 April 2017 at 8:20 A.M. Meeting notices were posted at the town hall and the town website. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Richardson. Supervisors King and Trowbridge along with patrolman Bill Richardson were in attendance. There were no guests.

Inspection areas of concern were noted to be as follows:

- Grind the existing road on 290th Ave (Highbanks Road)
- Repair damaged areas on the shoulders on 122nd St (Chain Lake Road)
- Grading required on town roadways
- Various road signs and E911 signs need to be replaced
- Three culverts need to be replaced
- Pot holes need to be filled on various roads
- The annual road inspection of all town roads using the State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation PASER (Pavement Surface Evaluation and Rating) criteria will be done this fall.

After the completion of the trip, in which the majority of the roads were inspected, a motion was made by Supervisor King to adjourn the meeting. Supervisor Trowbridge seconded the motion and all present voted aye. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 1:30 P.M.
