

**TOWN OF SAMPSON
SPECIAL MEETING
17 MAY 2016**

A **Special Meeting** of the Sampson Town Board was called to order by Chairman Richardson on **Tuesday, May 17th** at 12:03 P.M. at the Sampson Town Hall located at 10770 270th Ave. Supervisors King and Trowbridge were present, as was Clerk/Treasurer Reed and Patrolman Richardson. There were two guests.

The sole purpose of the meeting was to **open the bids for the LRIP** project that had been posted in the Bloomer Advance for two consecutive weeks, the town website and the three designated areas. Copies of the bids had also been faxed to Senn Blacktop, Monarch Paving and Chippewa County Highway Department.

The town had **received two sealed bids** and both of the representatives were present for the opening. Chairman Richardson opened the bid for **Senn Blacktop** which totaled **\$67,710.80**. He then opened the bid from **Chippewa County Highway Department** which totaled **\$70,148.60**. (A bid from Monarch Paving had not been received.)

A motion was made by **Supervisor Trowbridge to accept the bid from Senn Blacktop as presented**. Supervisor King seconded the Motion and all present voted aye. Motion carried.

When asked **when the project may be started**, Chuck Kuba-representative from Senn Blacktop, stated that it would probably be sometime in July. The bid specified that the work was to be completed no later than 1 September 2016.

Since this project is over \$65,000, **an engineer's certificate** will need to be submitted by Senn Blacktop, stating that the project will be designed and constructed to last a minimum of ten years.

There being no further business, a Motion was made by Supervisor King to adjourn the meeting. Chairman Richardson seconded the Motion and all present voted Aye. Motion carried, meeting adjourned at 12:10 P.M.
