

**Town of Sampson  
Regular Board Meeting  
Monday, June 5<sup>th</sup> 2017**

The **regular board meeting** of the Town of Sampson was called to order at the Sampson Town Hall on **Monday, June 5<sup>th</sup> 2017** at 7:00 P.M. Notices were posted at the Town Hall, the town web site and the Bloomer Advance. The meeting was called to order by Chairman C. Richardson. Supervisors King and Trowbridge were present as was Clerk/Treasurer Reed. There were seven guests.

Chairman Richardson opened the meeting with the reciting of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Board members had received copies of the **Board minutes** of the regular board meeting held on **Monday, May 1<sup>st</sup>**. A Motion was made by Supervisor Trowbridge to approve the minutes. Supervisor King seconded the motion and all present voted Aye. Motion carried.

Board members had received copies of the **Special Board minutes** of the regular board meeting held on **Monday, May 8<sup>th</sup>**. A Motion was made by Supervisor Trowbridge to approve the minutes. Supervisor King seconded the motion and all present voted Aye. Motion carried.

Clerk/Treasurer Reed gave the **Treasurer's report** and it was approved as read.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

**Kris Javarek** expressed her frustration regarding getting a RAZE document for the demolition of her home on Long Lake in the aftermath of the explosion that had taken place earlier in the year. After discussion and input from Don Granger, Supervisor Trowbridge advised her to contact the WI Insurance Commissioner. The Town Board would have no jurisdiction over this matter.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

The Board went into new business as there were guests present for the opening of the **blacktop/shouldering bid on 290<sup>th</sup> Ave (Highbanks Road)**. Three bids were received, reviewed and discussed. A motion was made by Supervisor Trowbridge to approve the bid from Monarch Paving Company for \$190,198.20. Supervisor King seconded the Motion and all present voted aye. Motion carried. Chairman Richardson signed the bid and thanked those that had submitted bids.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

Patrolman Richardson gave an **update on town road work**. All culverts have been replaced on 290<sup>th</sup> Ave. Chairman Richardson stated that **no more culvert work** will be done without the Board approval. The 290<sup>th</sup> Ave reclaiming project will start on June 7<sup>th</sup>. The end loader and mower have both been in need of repair. He stated he has been mowing the roadway on 290<sup>th</sup> Ave. Chairman Richardson directed Patrolman Richardson to spend at least one day replacing road signage throughout the township. Supervisor King will send an email reply to R. Stanbury regarding road work on his road.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

A **new application for the 2017-2018 Class B Beer and Liquor License** was reviewed for Stephanie Salem for King's Inn. A Motion was made by Supervisor King to approve the application. Supervisor Trowbridge seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The **2017-2018 Class B Beer and Liquor licenses and 1 Class A Liquor/Beer** were reviewed. A Motion was made by Chairman Richardson to approve the renewal applications. Supervisor Trowbridge seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The **2017-2018 Cigarette licenses** were reviewed. A Motion was made by Supervisor Trowbridge to approve the three cigarette renewal applications. Supervisor King seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The **2017-2018 Operator licenses** were reviewed. A Motion was made by Chairman Richardson to approve 26 renewal applications. Supervisor King seconded the motion. Motion carried.

An **operator's license application** for Lori Mayer was reviewed. A Motion was made by Chairman Richardson to approve the application. Supervisor King seconded the motion and all present voted aye. Motion carried.

**OTHER BUSINESS:**

The next regular Board meeting will be held on **Monday, July 10<sup>th</sup>** due to the July 4<sup>th</sup> Holiday.

**Vouchers were then presented and audited.** Supervisor King made a motion to approve vouchers 19061-19091 plus four electronic transfers. Supervisor Trowbridge seconded the motion. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Chairman Richardson to **adjourn the meeting.** Supervisor King seconded the motion. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:05 P.M.
