

**2015 Public Budget Hearing
Thursday, November 5th 2015**

The Public Budget Hearing on the proposed 2016 budget for the Town of Sampson was called to order by Chairman Richardson at 6:00 P.M. Supervisors King and Trowbridge and Clerk/Treasurer Reed and 3 guests were in attendance. Notices were placed in the three designated areas, the town website and the Bloomer Advance. Copies of the proposed 2016 budget were made available to all attendees. All attendees signed the poll list. Chairman Richardson read the proposed values of the budget and explained the application of \$70,000 to lower the levy. Chairman Richardson stated that the town does not have any outstanding debt. He also stated that the budget was set at the state mandated levy limit.

The proposed totals are as follows:

Expected Expenditures.....	\$605,313
Less Expected Revenues.....	-\$255,120
Less Surplus Funds.....	<u>-\$70,000</u>
Proposed Town Levy.....	\$280,193
(State mandated levy limit was \$280,193.)	

Statements regarding 2015 revenues and expenses were explained by the Board and Clerk. Various questions from the electors were answered by the Board and Clerk.
