

**Town of Sampson
Regular Board Meeting
Monday, March 6th 2017**

The **regular board meeting** of the Town of Sampson was called to order at the Sampson Town Hall on **Monday, March 6th 2017** at 7:00 P.M. Notices were posted at the Town Hall, the town web site and the Bloomer Advance. The meeting was called to order by Chairman C. Richardson. Supervisors King and Trowbridge were present as was Clerk/Treasurer Reed. Patrolman Bill Richardson was present. There were no guests.

Board members had received copies of the **Board minutes** of the regular board meeting held on **Monday, Feb 13th**. A Motion was made by Supervisor Trowbridge to approve the minutes. Supervisor King seconded the motion and all present voted Aye. Motion carried.

Clerk/Treasurer Reed gave the **Treasurer's report** and it was approved as read.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Clerk Reed asked if the Board would like to send flowers in memory of Phyllis Vetterkind who was Clerk/Treasurer from 1985-1995. The Board thought it was appropriate.

OLD BUSINESS:

Patrolman Richardson gave his update on the **town road issues**. He recommended that a crown be added for better drainage on 290th Ave in the area of Highbanks Road. He also stated that the mower was being repaired by Chippewa County Highway Department and a few more things are being done to it than originally thought. The town has not received any bids for the culverts on Highbanks Road, but anticipates there will be some for the bid opening at the next board meeting on April 3rd.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Board then discussed the date for the **annual road inspection**. It was decided to have it on **Monday, April 10th** at 8:00 A.M.

The **delinquent personal property listing** was reviewed with only two names on the list. Clerk Reed had sent out letters on Feb 21st requesting payment by March 15th.

The Board then discussed the proposed **ditch clean-up program** sponsored by the Chippewa County Recycling Department. A Motion was made by Chairman Richardson not to participate in the program. Supervisor King seconded the motion and all present voted aye. Motion carried.

An event permit was presented for the **Bethany Ski Team** from July 15th-21st. A motion was made by Chairman Richardson to approve the permit. Supervisor Trowbridge seconded the motion and all present voted aye. Motion carried.

OTHER BUSINESS:

The next regular Board meeting will be held on **Monday, April 3rd**. The **Spring Election** will be held **Tuesday, April 4th**. The **2017 Town Annual Meeting** will be held **Tuesday, April 18th**. The Town will host the **Chippewa County Unit** of the Wisconsin Towns Association meeting on **Tuesday, April 25th**. Clerk Reed will attend the **WTA District** meeting on Saturday, March 25th.

Vouchers were then presented and audited. Supervisor King made a motion to approve vouchers 18979-18912 plus four electronic transfers. Supervisor Trowbridge seconded the motion. All present voted aye. Motion carried.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Supervisor Trowbridge to **adjourn the meeting**. Chairman Richardson seconded the motion. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:30 P.M.
