

# 7 APRIL 2014 (REG)

**Town of Sampson  
Regular Board Meeting  
Monday, April 7<sup>th</sup> 2014**

The regular **Board Meeting** of the Town of Sampson was called to order on Monday, April 7<sup>th</sup> 2014 at 7:00 P.M. Notices were posted in the three designated areas, the Bloomer Advance and the town web site. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Butterfield. Supervisor Richardson was present as was Clerk/Treasurer Reed. Supervisor North was absent. There were no guests.

Chairman Butterfield led the meeting attendees in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Board members had received copies of the **board minutes** of the regular board meeting held **Monday, March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2014**. A Motion was made by Supervisor Richardson to approve the minutes. Chairman Butterfield seconded the motion and all present voted Aye. Motion carried.

**Treasurer's report** was given and accepted as read.

## **PUBLIC COMMENT:**

A question arose from Supervisor Richardson regarding the road ban rules for individuals driving home with trucks from work. Chairman Butterfield stated that the road bans have to be implemented for all trucks over the 10 ton limit and every effort is made to notify D.O.T. of violations.

## **OLD BUSINESS:**

There was no old business.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

Clerk Reed reported that there are **two delinquent 2013 personal property bills** left unpaid. She is to contact them again for payment plus months' interest on unpaid balance until paid in full.

**Road bans** have gone into effect starting Monday, March 31<sup>st</sup>. Notices were posted in the three designated areas and the Bloomer Advance.

Clerk Reed asked if the trim on the **hall doors and entry ways be varnished** as the old varnish is peeling off. She had contacted Ronnestrand Painting for an estimate. Estimate is \$650.00. Supervisor Richardson made a motion to have the work done. Chairman Butterfield seconded the motion and all present voted Aye. Motion carried. Clerk Reed will make arrangements to have the project done.

A Motion was made by Chairman Butterfield to set the date for the **annual road inspection** for **Monday, May 5<sup>th</sup>** and to depart the Town Hall at 9:00 AM. Supervisor Richardson seconded the motion and all present voted Aye. Motion carried.

A Motion was made by Supervisor Richardson to set the date for the **2014 Board of Review for Saturday, May 31<sup>st</sup> from 10:00 A.M.-12:00 P.M. with Open Book from 8:00 A.M -10:00 A.M. the same day.** Chairman Butterfield seconded the motion and all present voted Aye. Motion carried.

A Motion was made by Chairman Butterfield to approve the **Bethany Ski Team Permit** from July 19-25 2014. Supervisor Richardson seconded the motion and all present voted Aye. Motion carried.

A Motion was made by Chairman Butterfield to **two operator license applications** for YaJuan Woodford and Sally Lewis. Supervisor Richardson seconded the motion and all present voted Aye. Motion carried.

Chairman Butterfield reported on the **Bloomer Ambulance and Recycling meeting** that he attended on March 24<sup>th</sup> and the **W.T.A. meeting** he attended on March 29<sup>th</sup>. He received the appropriate training to be certified as a member of the Board of Review for 2014-2016.

#### **OTHER BUSINESS:**

Clerk Reed gave an update on the plans for the **Sampson Elected Officials Plaque** dedication that will be on Tuesday, April 15<sup>th</sup>. This event is open to the public. The event starts at 5:00 P.M. and there have been responses from area politicians that plan on attending the formal presentation at 6:00 P.M. There will be old town memorabilia displayed and a lunch will be served. The Annual Town Meeting will follow.

The next town board meeting will be on **Monday, May 5th** starting at 7:00 p.m.

**Vouchers were then presented and audited.** Chairman Butterfield made a motion to approve vouchers 18007-18027 plus five electronic transfers. Supervisor Richardson seconded the motion and all present voted Aye. Motion carried.

There being no further business made a motion was made by Chairman Butterfield to adjourn the meeting. Supervisor Richardson seconded the motion and all present voted aye. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:30 P.M.
