

**Town of Sampson  
Regular Board Meeting  
Tuesday, Sept 8 2015**

The regular board meeting of the Town of Sampson was called to order on **Tuesday, 8 Sept 2015** at 7:00 P.M. Notices were posted in the three designated areas, the town web site and the Bloomer Advance. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Richardson. Supervisors King and Trowbridge were present as was Clerk/Treasurer Reed. There were no guests.

Chairman Richardson led the meeting attendees in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Board members had received copies of the **Board minutes** of the regular board meeting held **Monday, August 10<sup>th</sup>**. A Motion was made by Supervisor Trowbridge to approve the minutes. Supervisor King seconded the motion and all present voted Aye. Motion carried.

Board members had received copies of the **Special Meeting minutes** held **Tuesday, 1 Sept 2015**. A Motion was made by Supervisor King to approve the minutes. Supervisor Trowbridge seconded the motion and all present voted Aye. Motion carried.

**Treasurer's report** was given and accepted as read.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

There was no public comment.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

Chairman Richardson stated that **Duncan Creek Road (90<sup>th</sup> St)** has been blacktopped and will be shouldered in the near future. Chippewa County Highway department has hauled gravel on various other dirt roads in the township and will also be crushing gravel sometime in October. Mowing will continue throughout the township. The Board will have a **Special Meeting on Friday, October 9<sup>th</sup>** to do a road inspection trip in preparation for the 2016 budget workshop.

The **acoustics in the town hall** was discussed. The Board feels there is no reason to spend additional money on the hall acoustics at this time. Tabled until further notice.

Chairman Richardson stated that prior to this meeting the Board held a special closed meeting **and hired Patrick Blodgett** for the part time snow plow driver.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

An application with proper deposit and payment checks had been received from Patti Kellen to **rent the hall on Sunday, Sept 20<sup>th</sup>**. Supervisor King made a motion to authorize the hall rental. Supervisor Trowbridge seconded the motion and all present voted aye. Motion carried.

The date for the budget workshop was tabled until the next meeting and will be on the agenda for next month's meeting.

**OTHER BUSINESS:**

The next regular town board meeting will be on **Monday, October 5th** starting at 7:00 p.m.

**Vouchers were then presented and audited.** Supervisor Trowbridge made a motion to approve vouchers 18463-18475 plus five electronic transfers. Supervisor King seconded the motion. Motion carried.

There being no further business a motion was made by Supervisor King to **adjourn the meeting**. Chairman Richardson seconded the motion. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:30 P.M.
