

**2017 Public Budget Hearing

The Public Budget Hearing on the proposed 2018 budget for the Town of Sampson was called to order by Chairman Richardson at 6:00 P.M. Supervisors King and Trowbridge and Clerk/Treasurer Reed and four guests were in attendance. Notices were placed on the town website, town hall and the Bloomer Advance. Copies of the proposed 2018 budget were made available to all attendees. All attendees signed the poll list. Chairman Richardson read the proposed values of the budget. Chairman Richardson stated that the town does not have any outstanding debt. He also stated that the budget was set at the state mandated levy limit.

The proposed totals are as follows:

Expected Expenditures.....	\$596,935
Less Expected Revenues.....	-\$260,433
Less Surplus Funds.....	-\$50,000
Proposed Town Levy.....	\$286,502
(State mandated levy limit was \$286,502.)	

Statements regarding 2017 revenues and expenses were explained by the Board and Clerk. Various questions from the electors were answered by the Board and Clerk.
