

**TOWN OF SAMPSON
SPECIAL MEETING
1 Oct 2018**

A **Special Meeting** of the Sampson Town Board was called to order on **Monday, 1 Oct 2018 at 8:00 A.M.** The main purpose of the meeting was to inspect the roads within township. Meeting notices were posted at the town hall and the town website. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Richardson. Supervisors King and Trowbridge, along with patrolman Bill Richardson were in attendance. There were no guests.

Inspection areas of concern were noted to be as follows:

- Grading of town roads before winter
- Fill in pot holes on various roads
- Add gravel to newly replaced culvert on 167th St./ Plummer Lake Road
- Most of the roads remained the same grade as in the spring inspection except 70th St. , 110th St. and 100th St. were downgraded.
- Board members discussed various roads that could be worked on for next year but see how they hold up this winter.

After the completion of the trip, in which the majority of the roads were inspected, a motion was made by Supervisor King to adjourn the meeting. Chairman Richardson seconded the motion and all present voted aye. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 12:00 P.M.
