

**Town of Sampson  
Special Meeting  
October 23<sup>rd</sup> 2019**

A Special Meeting of the Sampson Town Board was held on **Wednesday, October 23<sup>rd</sup> 2019**. Notices were posted at the town hall and the town website. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Trowbridge at 8:00 A.M. Supervisors King and Jerabek were present. Patrolman Richardson was also present. There were no other guests.

The purpose of the meeting was to **prepare the 2020 town budget**. The work session discussed all 2018 revenues and expenses, actual and anticipated revenues and expenses for 2019 and proposed appropriations for each account for 2020.

The Board also discussed the Local Road Improvement Project concerning timing, funding and expenses of the LRIP. After considerable discussion, Supervisor King made a motion to designate the project for a 1 mile section of 290<sup>th</sup> Ave (Basswood Road) heading west from 152<sup>nd</sup> St (Sand Lake Road). Bids will go out in April 2021. Supervisor Jerabek seconded the motion and all voted aye. Motion carried. The LRIP will be budgeted for accordingly in the **2021** town budget.

The 2020 budget was established and the levy was set at **\$295,463** within the limits mandated by the State. The date for the Public Budget Hearing will be on **Monday, November 11<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 P.M.** The regular November Board Meeting will follow.

A Motion was made by Supervisor King and seconded by Supervisor Jerabek to adjourn the meeting. Meeting adjourned at 9:30 A.M.
