

2019 Public Budget Hearing

The Public Budget Hearing on the **proposed 2020 budget** for the Town of Sampson was called to order by Chairman Trowbridge at 7:00 P.M. Supervisors King and Jerabek, Clerk/Treasurer Reed and eight guests were in attendance. Notices were placed on the town website, town hall and two other designated places and the Bloomer Advance. Copies of the proposed 2020 budget were made available to all attendees. All attendees signed the poll list. Chairman Trowbridge read the proposed values of the budget. Chairman Trowbridge stated that the town does not have any outstanding debt. He also stated that the budget was set at the state mandated levy limit.

The proposed totals are as follows:

Expected Expenditures.....	\$631,802
Less Expected Revenues.....	-\$261,339
Less Surplus Funds.....	-\$75,000
Proposed Town Levy.....	\$295,463

(State mandated levy limit was \$295,463.)

Questions from the electors were answered by the Board and Clerk.
