## Town of Sampson Chippewa County Ordinance #1-2019

The Town Board of the Town of Sampson, Chippewa County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.13, Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the regulation of the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on town highways in the town as follows:

- A. The stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on the following town road in the Town of Sampson is subject to the following restrictions and limitations:
  - On 290th Avenue, (also known as Basswood Road), no parking shall be allowed on the north side of said road within 500 feet in either direction of the Long Lake public boat landing entrance.
- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described roadway on or before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No persons may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways in violation of the above-noted stopping, standing, or parking restrictions and limitations. Any violation will be penalized by the Town of Sampson Penalties Ordinance #1-2007 and #2-2007.

This ordinance will become effective on August 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats. posted July 15<sup>th</sup> 2019 at the Town Hall and Town website and published in the Bloomer Advance as a Class 2 notice on July 17<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> 2019.

This Ordinance was adopted at a regular Board meeting August 5th 2019.
