

**Town of Sampson
Special Budget Workshop
October 16th 2020**

A Special Budget Workshop of the Sampson Town Board was held on **Tuesday, October 16th 2020**. Notices were posted at the town hall and the town website. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Trowbridge at 8:00 A.M. Supervisors King and Jerabek were present. Patrolman Richardson was also present. There were no guests.

Chairman Trowbridge opened the meeting with the discussion regarding the purchase of a new town truck. The specifications were reviewed from both Southworth and the Chippewa County Highway Department. After considerable discussion, a motion was made by Supervisor Jerabek to purchase the truck from Southworth Chevrolet and have the additional specialized equipment installed by the Chippewa County Highway Department for a total cost of \$30,675.12. Supervisor King seconded the motion and Jerabek and King voted aye. Trowbridge voted nay. Motion carried. The expense of the truck will be taken off the 2020 expenses under Capital Outlay-Equipment Replacement

The board then moved on to **prepare the 2021 town budget**. The work session discussed all 2019 revenues and expenses, actual and anticipated revenues and expenses for 2020 and proposed appropriations for each account for 2021.

The 2021 budget was established and the levy was set at **\$298,849** within the limits mandated by the State. The date for the **Public Budget Hearing will be on Monday, November 16th at 6:30 P.M.** The regular November Board Meeting will follow.

A Motion was made by Supervisor King and seconded by Supervisor Jerabek to adjourn the meeting. Meeting adjourned at 9:45 A.M.
