Resolution #3-2021

A resolution regarding the Town of Sampson Breezy Point Boat Landing Property.

Whereas the Town of Sampson owns a piece of property on Breezy Point Road (135th street) that was at one time developed as a boat landing; and

Whereas the above mentioned property has not been used as a boat landing for many years and is in fact not currently able to be used as a site for the launching of trailered boats as it has fallen into disrepair; and

Whereas the control of invasive species has become a high priority on Long Lake and is currently monitored at the Morris Erickson Park boat landing; and


Whereas in discussion with the Lower Long Lake Protective and Rehabilitation District it was found to not be desirable to reopen the Breezy Point landing for trailered boat launching due to the fact that it would not be monitored for invasive species;

Now therefore the Town of Sampson does resolve to not reopen this site for the launching of trailered boats. Rather the Town will clean up and minimally develop this site to provide carry in access for canoes and kayaks. Such development will be limited to a small parking area for the public and improvement of the drainage on the site.


