

**TOWN OF SAMPSON  
SPECIAL MEETING  
January 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022**

The meeting was called to order at 6 p.m. by Chairperson Jerabek who led the group in the pledge of allegiance. Present were Clerk/Treasurer Darla Butterfield, 2<sup>nd</sup> Supervisor Carol Butterfield, Road Patrolman Bill Richardson, and Chairperson Jerabek. 1<sup>st</sup> Supervisor King was absent due to a family emergency. Darren Nyrose was present from Delmore Consulting to present a report on the data they collected in the Township on roads, culverts, and signage. One member of the public was also present.

Darren went over examples of the data that had been collected by Delmore. He also presented the Town Board with a complete binder of the data as well as a digital version that can be used on any computer.

Several questions were asked by board members, employees, as well as the public. The presentation lasted just over an hour. Darren stated that Jeff Delmore, the head of the firm, would return to our next regular board meeting to discuss road ratings and recommendations for maintenance. Jeff was supposed to be at the meeting tonight but illness prevented him from attending so Darren took his place. Jeff is the expert on the road maintenance.

No decision was made on hiring Delmore for a second year. This was tabled until the board receives the final report at the February meeting.

After Darren left, considerable discussion was held concerning the data presented. All present agreed that it was very helpful thus far.

There being no further business, Supervisor Butterfield made a motion to adjourn, Chairperson Jerabek seconded the motion and all voted in favor.
